## 1. Explain reading materials appropriate to course levels.

The Annotated Bibliography assignment is an assessment of SCCLO #1. The assessment measures the student's ability to find and utilize reading materials appropriate to the Animal Anatomy & Physiology course that will be used to write and present a final research paper.

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**Sources**  
Find at least five peer-reviewed sources on your topic. These must come from peer-reviewed literature. Other sources can be included from text books, personal interviews, and current published material. Then create an annotated bibliography.

**Format**  
An annotated bibliography should include the complete citation of each article in APA format. [https://owl.purdue.edu/owl/research\\_and\\_citation/apa\\_style/apa\\_formatting\\_and\\_style\\_guide/general\\_format.html](https://owl.purdue.edu/owl/research_and_citation/apa_style/apa_formatting_and_style_guide/general_format.html) as it will appear in your reference list. **Below the citation, provide bullet points describing the main findings of the paper and how those findings relate to your topic.**

Preparing an annotated bibliography gives you an opportunity to find sources and take notes while you read them. Primary literature is dense, and using your notes to remind yourself of the key points can save you time when you begin writing the literature review.
